



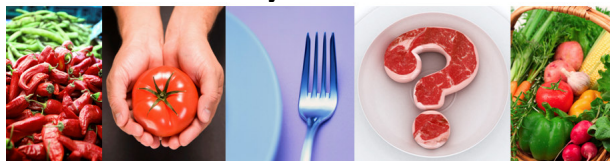
A morning workshop aimed at providing curriculum resources and ideas to integrate edible gardens into the curriculum.
